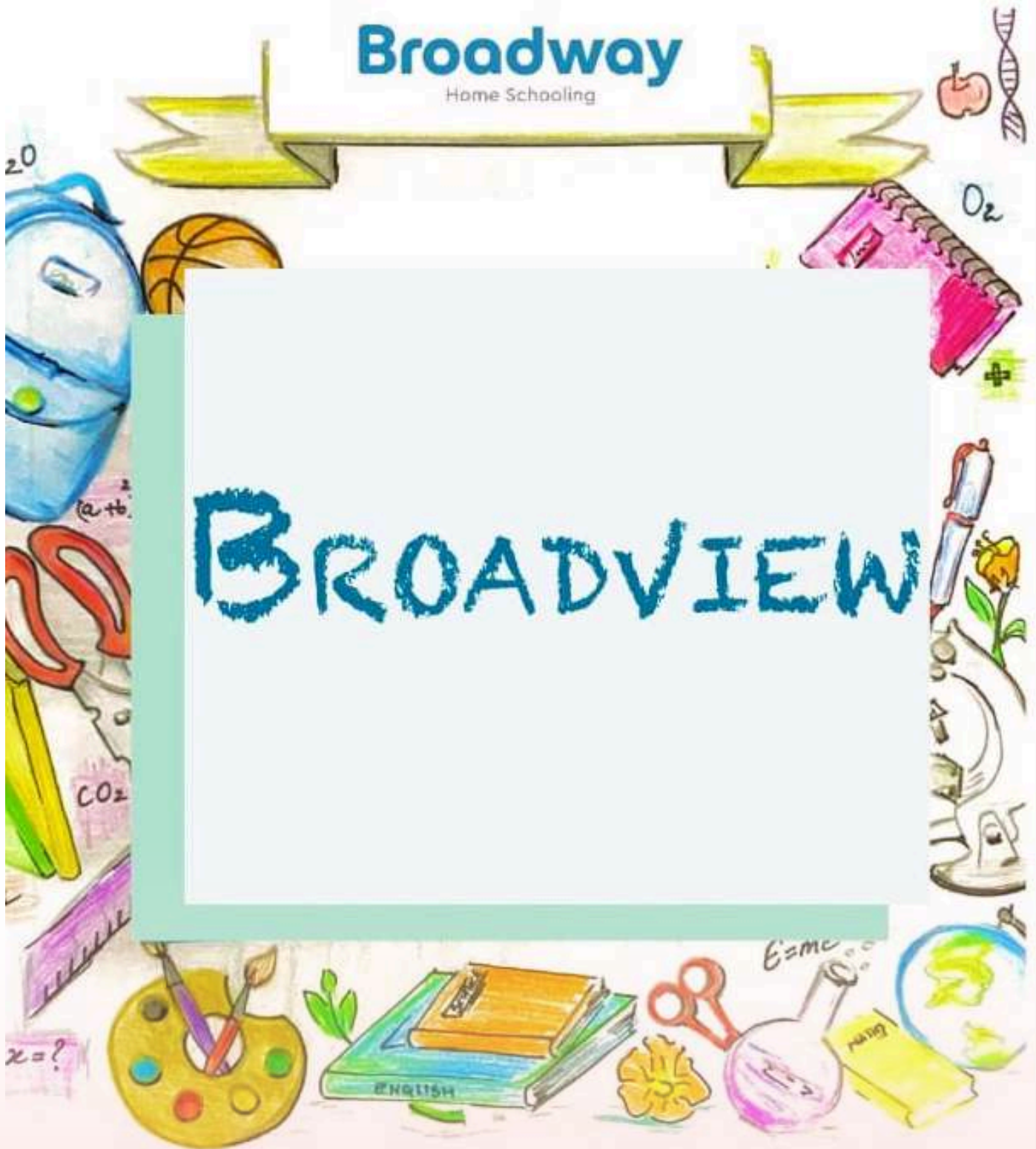

As you flip through these pages, you will discover not only the academic and extracurricular achievements of our students but also their reflections, aspirations, and voices.

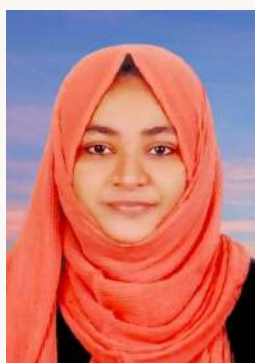

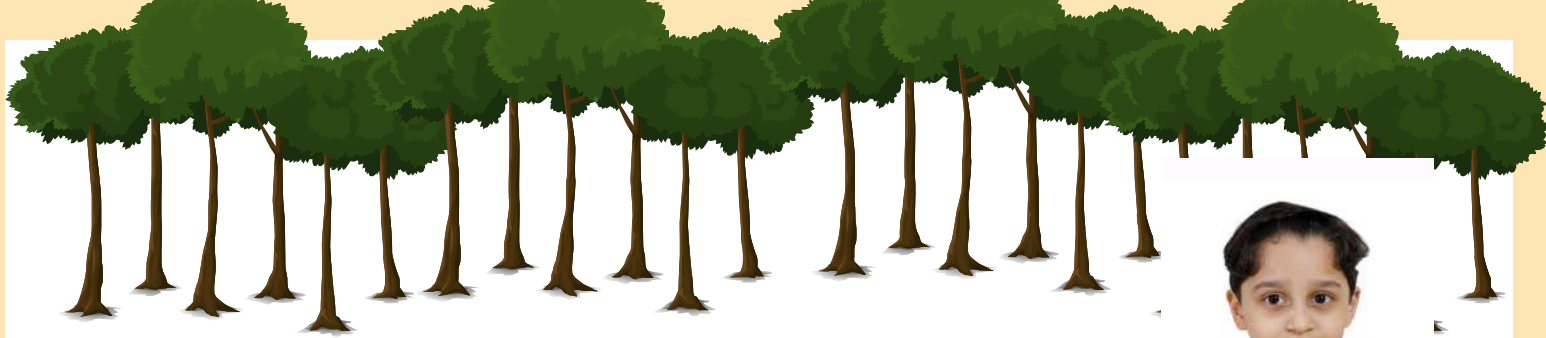
Closing Ceremony And Awards

THE MYSTERY DOOR

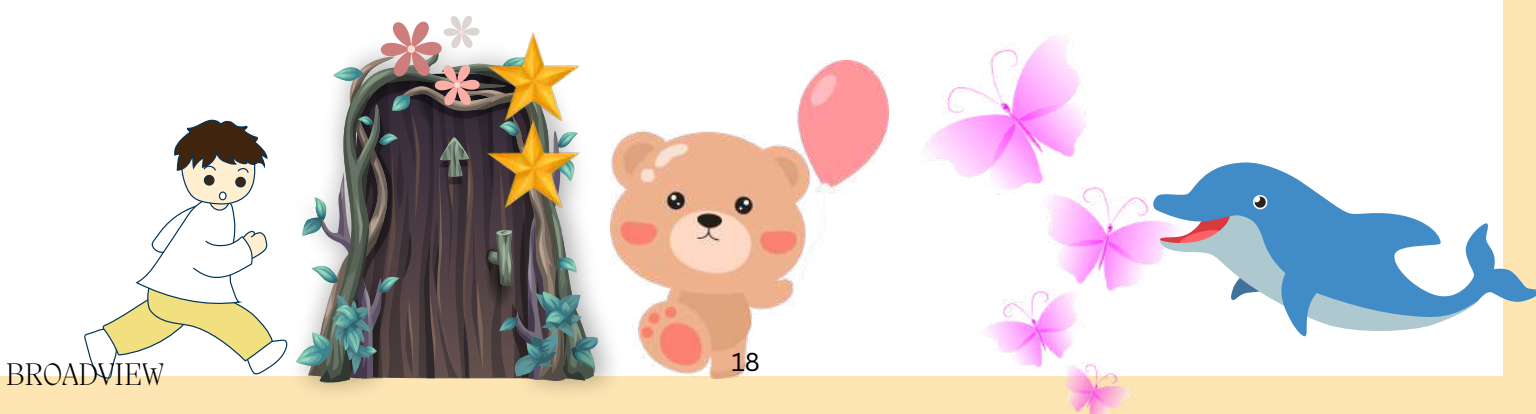
Once upon a time in a small village, there lived a boy named Aboobacker. He was known for his kindness and bravery, and everyone in the village loved him dearly.

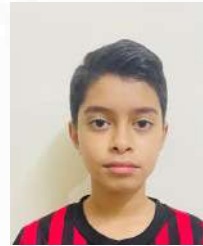


THE STOLEN NECKLACE OF JOHN
