"Have you created anything for the meeting?" Ant-Man asked eagerly.

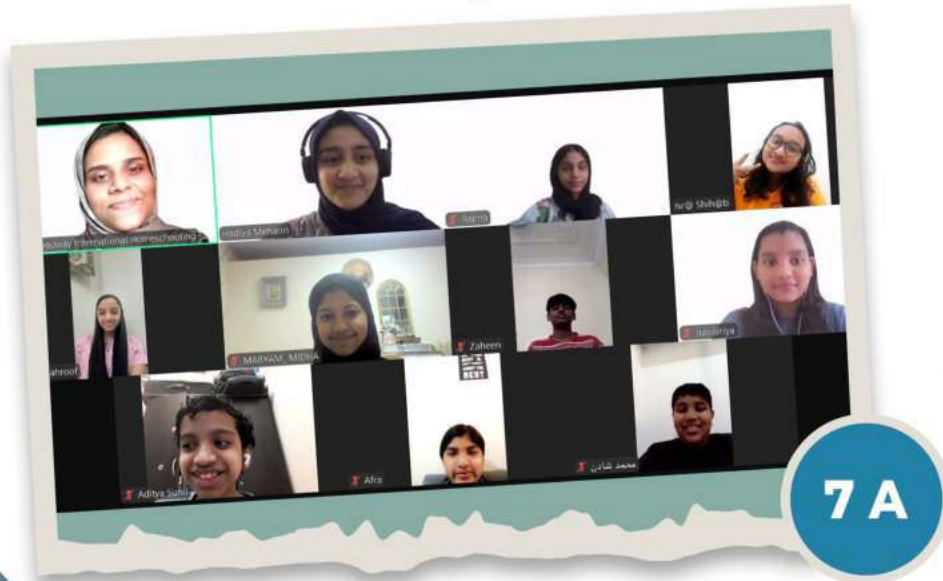
"Yes," Hulk said proudly, showing them his invention: a super-strength booster that could make anyone as strong as the Hulk for a limited time.

The twin tower is a place that any tourist who comes to Malaysia must visit, no tourist returns from Malaysia without taking a photo in front of the twin tower. The world's largest twin tower is the twin tower. The construction of the Twin Towers took six years from 1993 to 1998, and until 2004, the Twin Towers were the tallest buildings in the world. All public transportation facilities, including metro and bus services, are connected to the Twin Towers. The beautiful garden in front of the Twin Towers and the KLCC shopping complex adjacent to the tower are also very attractive. The office complex of Petronas, Malaysia's largest petroleum company, is located inside the Twin Towers.



hustle and bustle of Kuala Lumpur to the new city. Today, many high-rise buildings, including the Prime Minister's Office, can be seen in the area that consisted of oil palm plantations and swampy areas. Cyberjaya, an IT industry center, is also located nearby.

The city was built in harmony with the environment. A man-made lake, and a huge bridge like an anchored ship built in Iranian architecture across it. The city construction, which began in 1995, was completed in 2001.

This area, which was part of the state of Selangor, is now a federal territory.

There are many wonders here, such as Wisma Putra, the headquarters of the Department of Foreign

Affairs, Perdana Putra, the Prime Minister's office complex with green minarets, the official residence of Sari Pradhan, the botanical garden, and the park. Malaysia is a democratic country. There is no security for ministers or the king that prevents people from walking. Visitors have access to the gate of the Prime Minister's office, without any checking.


The mosque on the shores of Lake Putrajaya is a center of attraction. The fifty-meter-high pink dome of the mosque was built using rose granite. The construction of the mosque, which began in 1977, was completed in two years. The mosque, which can accommodate 15,000 people at a time, also has a prayer hall, a courtyard, and a dormitory. Visitors are allowed to enter the mosque. Women must wear a red gown to enter.

## **BATHU CAVES**

Batu Caves are located in the state of Selangor, 13 kilometers from Kuala Lumpur. They are an important place of worship for the Tamils in limestone caves that are believed to have been formed four hundred million years ago. A 140-foot-tall gold-plated statue can be seen outside the entrance of the cave. This is the largest Murugan statue in the world. The construction of the statue was completed in 2006. It is said that it cost 300 tons of steel, 1550 cubic meters of concrete and 300 liters of gold paint.

You have to climb 272 steep steps to reach the cave. The concrete steps are made of rainbow colors and are colorful. You can see many pigeons and people feeding them. There are also monkeys on the way. If you climb the steps, you will reach the wide cave face.

The cave, which is formed from limestone that is always covered with water, gives an indescribable visual beauty. It is surrounded by stone figures hanging from the white limestone rock. The top of the cave is empty. The sun's rays filter through it. Potekkatt mentions the Bathu caves in his 'Malayan Nadu'. He described them as a den of robbers. Today, many films have been shot here. Some parts of the Tamil film Kabali were shot here



1956 നവംബർ 1 ന് മലയാളം പ്രധാന ഭാഷയായ പ്രദേശങ്ങളെല്ലാം കുട്ടിച്ചേർത്തതുകൊണ്ട് കേരളസംസ്ഥാനം രൂപീകരിച്ചതിൻറെ ഓർമ്മ പുതുക്കാൻ അന്നേ ദിവസം മുതൽ ഒരാഴ്ചക്കാലം ദൈർഘ്യമുള്ള പരിപാടികൾ മലയാളവിഭാഗം സംഘടിപ്പിച്ചു. അതിൽ വിവിധ ക്ലാസ്സുകളിലെ കുട്ടികൾ പങ്കെടുക്കുകയും സമ്മാനാർഹരാവുകയും ചെയ്തിട്ടുണ്ട്. വൈവിധ്യമാർന്ന മതങ്ങളുടെയും സംസ്കാരങ്ങളുടെയും നാടായ കേരളത്തിൻറെ മലയാള തനിമയോടെയുള്ള വസ്ത്രധാരണവും ആശംസ അർപ്പിക്കലും വിവിധ രീതിയിലുള്ള കേരള ഭൂപടനിർമ്മാണവും കേരളീയ പൈതൃകത്തെ അനുസ്മരിപ്പിക്കുന്ന നാടൻ പാട്ടുകളുടെ അവതരണവും ചോദ്യോത്തരപരമ്പരകളും കേരളപ്പിറവി ദിനത്തിൽ നമ്മുടെ സ്കൂളിൽ നടത്തിയ മത്സര ഇനങ്ങളാണ്. ഇത്തരം മത്സരപരിപാടികളിലൂടെ കുട്ടികൾക്ക് അറിവു നൽകുന്നതുകൂടാതെ പഠിതാക്കളെ മുൻനിരയിലേക്ക് കൊണ്ടുവരത്തക്ക രീതിയിലുള്ള പ്രവർത്തന സജ്ജമായ ഒരു വേദികൂടി മലയാളവിഭാഗം മുന്നോട്ട് വയ്ക്കുന്നു എന്ന ആഹ്ലാദകരമായ ഓർമ്മയ്ക്കൊപ്പംതന്നെ അതിനുവേണ്ടി സഹായിച്ച സഹപ്രവർത്തകരെയും ഓരോ പരിപാടിയും പങ്കെടുത്ത് വിജയിപ്പിക്കുന്ന കുട്ടികളെയും ഈ അവസരത്തിൽ നന്ദിപൂർവ്വം ഓർക്കുന്നു.

മണലിന്റെ നഗരിയായ ദുബായിയുടെ ഹൃദയഭാഗത്ത് ആകാശത്തേക്ക് കൈയേറിയുണർക്കുന്ന ഒരു അത്ഭുതമാണ് ബുർജ് ഖലീഫ. 828 മീറ്റർ ഉയരമുള്ള ഈ കെട്ടിടം, 163 നിലകളുമായി, മനുഷ്യന്റെ സാങ്കേതിക കഴിവിന്റെ ഉത്തമ ഉദാഹരണമാണ്.

ബുർജ് ഖലീഫയുടെ നിർമ്മാണം 2004 സെപ്റ്റംബറിൽ ആരംഭിച്ച് 2010 ജനുവരി 4-ന് സമാപിച്ചു.

ഇതിന്റെ ആകെയുള്ള നിർമ്മാണ ചെലവ് ഏകദേശം 1.5 ബില്യൺ ഡോളറാണ്.

ബുർജ് ഖലീഫയുടെ 124-ാം നിലയിൽ 'അറ്റ് ദി ടോപ്' എന്ന പേരിൽ ഒരു നിരീക്ഷണ ഡെക്ക് ഉണ്ട്, അവിടെ നിന്ന് ദുബായിയുടെ മനോഹര കാഴ്ചകൾ ആസ്വദിക്കാം. പുതുവത്സര ആഘോഷങ്ങളിൽ ബുർജ് ഖലീഫയിലെ വെടിക്കെട്ട് പ്രപഞ്ചപ്രശസ്തമാണ്, ഇത് കാണാൻ ലോകത്തിന്റെ വിവിധ ഭാഗങ്ങളിൽ നിന്ന് ആയിരക്കണക്കിന് ആളുകൾ എത്തുന്നു. ബുർജ് ഖലീഫയുടെ നിർമ്മാണത്തിൽ ദക്ഷിണ കൊറിയയിലെ സാംസങ്ങ് സി&ടി, ബെൽജിയത്തിലെ ബേസിക്സ്, യു.എ.ഇയിലെ അറബ്‌ടെക് എന്നീ കമ്പനികളുടെ സഹകരണമാണ് ഈ കെട്ടിടം യാഥാർത്ഥ്യമാക്കിയത്. ബുർജ് ഖലീഫയുടെ മുകളിൽ നിന്ന് 95 കിലോമീറ്റർ അകലെ നിന്ന് പോലും കാണാൻ കഴിയും, ഇത് ഇതിന്റെ ആകർഷകത്വം വർദ്ധിപ്പിക്കുന്നു. ഇവിടെ താമസിക്കുന്നതും പ്രവർത്തിക്കുന്നതുമായ ആളുകൾക്ക് ബുർജ് ഖലീഫ ഒരു പ്രൗഢിയുടെ പ്രതീകമാണ്. ഈ കെട്ടിടം ദുബായിയുടെ ആധുനികതയും പുരോഗതിയും പ്രതിഫലിപ്പിക്കുന്നു, ഇത് ലോകത്തിന്റെ വിവിധ ഭാഗങ്ങളിൽ നിന്നുള്ള വിനോദസഞ്ചാരികളെ ആകർഷിക്കുന്നു.

## ബഷീർ ദിനം

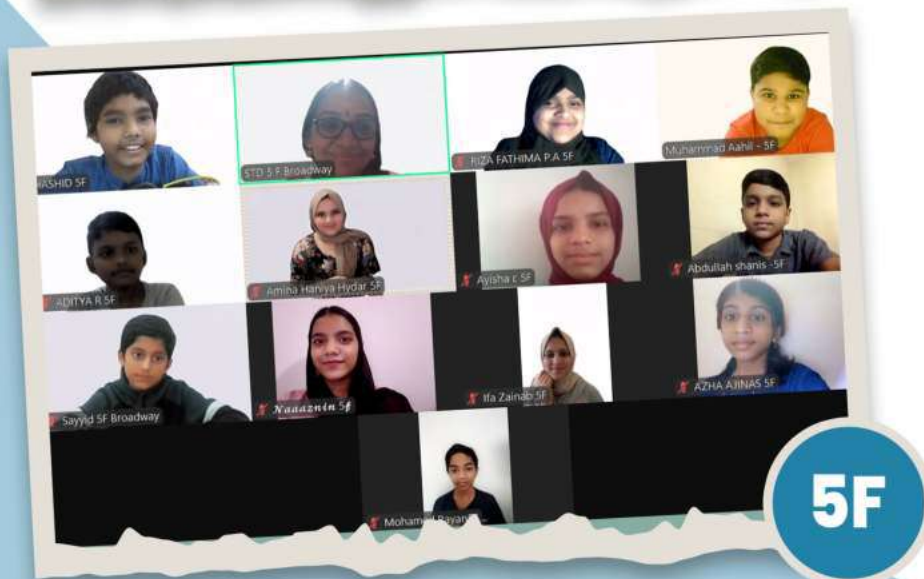
